### **Intravenous Pyelogram Preparation Requirements**

No food or drink 6 hours prior to the procedure. Inform the receptionist/radiographer of allergies to iodine or if there is a possibility of you being pregnant

### **Procedure**

An intravenous iodine based contrast medium is injected into a vein on your arm/ hand. X- rays are taken at intervals up to 30 minutes. Depending on the abnormality, further delay radiographs may be necessary. You will be asked to empty your bladder and a further radiograph will be taken.

### **After Procedure**

Normal activities can be resumed.
